



Fire/EMS Academy

This hands-on academy prepares juniors and seniors to be part of an emergency response team. Students will learn basic fire behavior and techniques used to control structural and related fire emergencies. The academy will also prepare students to provide emergency medical care sanctioned by WI Department of Health Services, for Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) scope of practice.

Upon successful completion of this academy, students will meet the requirements for Firefighter 1 certification with the State of Wisconsin (NFPA 1001, Professional Qualifications for Firefighter State of Wisconsin Certified Firefighter 1, IFSAC Accredited). Successful completion will also prepare students for the National Registry EMR written examination.
