**Notes:**

- Offerings with fewer than 3 graduates reporting employment (+35hrs/wk) in training-related positions lacked sufficient data to report information. Wage information reflect those in training-related occupations working 35 hours or more per week.
- Because many graduates were previously employed as supervisors, salaries shown are higher than entry-level.
- Many graduates from this program volunteer their services and receive no salary, while others are paid on a per call basis. Some graduates provide a salary that is a combination of their EMT wage and a wage from their primary occupation, which may also impact the listed information.
- Many of the graduates seeking municipal jobs can take 6-18 months to be processed for employment eligibility due to substantial testing and background checks.
- Annual average salaries are calculated using a 12 month formula, however many Educational Interpreter Technician graduates work on 9 month contracts.
