## **Come Check Out the Updated NTC Library!**

The NTC Library now has a “look and feel” that is much brighter, more open, and complements the overall atmosphere of NTC. We anticipate opening the second floor, which has additional new features, in mid September. Special features of the remodeled first floor include:

- Single service desk for a consistent point of service
- Expanded selection of electronic and online resources for anytime/anywhere access
- Enclosed patron seating area with Wi-Fi, booths, tall tables, a sink, and microwave
- Patron workstations, networked to a high speed printer. Several are attached to document scanners, one has an oversize monitor, and several include Zoom-Text. Student laptops (for use within the library – such as in study areas) are available for short-term checkout as well.
- Four small enclosed first-floor study rooms for individual and/or group study
- Large electronic display board for campus announcements and instructions on using online library materials
- First floor children’s area will support NTC’s Early Childhood Education program
- Naturally lighted study tables (with Wi-Fi and electricity) as well as casual seating for reading and/or relaxation
