

## Off Campus Access to NTC Library Resources

Many of the resources that the library provides have been set up to recognize NTC computers. If you are not working from an NTC computer you may have to enter your NTC network username and password to use them.

Please log on using your NTC logon and password. This is same logon (username) and password that you use to log onto any NTC computer when you are working on campus.

PLEASE NOTE: You must be affiliated with NTC to use our licensed electronic resources.  
If you are a Wisconsin resident, you can access the resources licensed for statewide use from the BadgerLink website at <http://www.badgerlink.org>.

If you are a student, your NTC username is your **NTC student ID number**. Your password is the password that you use to obtain access to any NTC computer.

If you are an NTC student and you do not remember your NTC network password, you may call the NTC library (1.888.NTC.7144 or 715.675.3331, Ext. 4054 or 4115) and ask us to reset it for you.

BadgerLink is a group of resources that the State of Wisconsin provides for all state residents. You do not need to be an NTC student to access BadgerLink if you are working from a computer that accesses the Internet through a "Wisconsin approved" Internet provider. You can access BadgerLink without your NTC username and password by using the link from the **Off Campus Users** section of the NTC library web page or by going directly to <http://www.badgerlink.net/>.

Note: If your Internet provider is not "Wisconsin approved" you may need to logon using either the NTC link or your local (public) library card number. There is a link on the BadgerLink page that will help you log on using your local library card number.

Note 2: NTC subscribes to several resources that are accessible through the BadgerLink interface if you log on as an NTC user. You will not see these resources in BadgerLink when you do not log on as a NTC user.

# Accessing BadgerLink from off-campus without an NTC Logon and Password

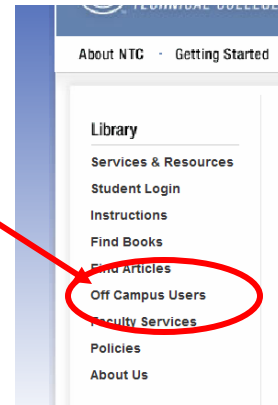
Begin by clicking the **Off Campus Users** link from the NTC Library home page.

## Accessing Databases

An NTC network logon is required to access many of the NTC databases from off campus. The logon and password that you use to access an NTC computer when working on campus. If you access online databases through the NTC library's [Find Articles](#) page it will automatically ask you for your logon and password if you are off-campus. If you do not know your NTC logon or are asked to supply additional "UserID/Password" please call 1.888.NTC.7144 or 715.675.3331 Ext. 4115.

NTC visitors have direct access to BadgerLink at <http://www.badgerlink.net>, but do not have access to most of the other databases provided by the NTC library. If you are unable to access please refer to the instructions under BadgerLink Help on the [BadgerLink](#) page. BadgerLink is recognize Wisconsin computers that use certain Internet Service Providers. You may need to use your public library card number as a password before you can enter BadgerLink using those providers.
