Northcentral Technical College (NTC) offers individuals the opportunity to take the next step in their learning journey. Whether their goal is a career in a skilled technical profession or further education at a four-year institution, NTC students are well prepared for their next step.

However, many students face financial barriers that prevent them from reaching their educational goals. Many have full or part-time jobs, are raising a family, and may be struggling to meet daily financial obligations. How you can help

Area of Greatest Need

This fund supports Foundation activities focused on developing continuing resources for the future. It also supplies funding for special projects that arise unexpectedly throughout the year.

Scholarships

Each year, more than 400 students receive NTC Foundation scholarships worth more than \$260,000. Yet this meets only 20% of the need for financial assistance. Your support can be directed to the general scholarship fund, existing named scholarships, or used to establish a new annual or endowed scholarship fund.

Special Student Loan Fund

This fund supports interest-free loans that help students through difficult financial situations that threaten their ability to continue their education. Eligible students can receive emergency assistance for basic needs such as car repairs, rent payments, medical treatment and child care.

New Initiatives

NTC and the Foundation are continually investigating new opportunities to provide greater educational opportunities to the community. Contributions to this area will help the college provide learning opportunities anywhere, anytime, for anyone in north central Wisconsin

Scholarship options

Donors can establish a new named scholarship and set the awarding criteria. Scholarship recipients who meet the criteria are selected by the Foundation through a college-wide selection process.

Annual Scholarship - minimum \$500

Annual Scholarship donors commit to a yearly contribution to fund the scholarship. 100% of the annual contribution is awarded to a student. The scholarship is awarded as long as funding is available.

Endowed Scholarship - minimum \$5000

Donors can create a self-perpetuating, or endowed scholarship. The endowed contribution is invested and scholarships are paid in perpetuity with interest and investment earnings. Five percent of an endowment value is annually awarded as a scholarship beginning one year after the full endowment is contributed.
