Program Overview

The Video Production Program track of the Graphic Communication Technologies Associate Degree provides a comprehensive overview of the equipment, concepts, and techniques needed to design, produce, and edit effective professional video products and introduces the primary tools needed for the creation of 2D and 3D animation projects. Specific areas covered in the program include pre-production processes: story development, scripting, storyboarding, scheduling and budgeting; production techniques: camera operation, lighting, interviewing, audio recording; and post-production workflow: capturing, editing, motion-graphics, sound design, rendering, outputting, and publishing. The program focuses on providing students with the hands-on technical skills necessary to create professional video products and to work in a variety of audio-visual media production and post-production capacities.

Potential Occupations include: Video Producer, Documentary filmmaker, Video Editor, Sound Recordist, Post-Production Supervisor, Freelance Videographer, Camera Operator, Radio-Television Operator, Production Assistant, Motion Graphics Designer, Animator, Creative Director, Video Archivist, Media Manager and Video Technician.

The Video Production Associate Degree is conveniently offered at our Wausau campus in both in-person and blended formats. Students may enter this program in the fall semester.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, (www.bls.gov) projected job openings in video production continue to grow at an average rate. The average starting wage in the industry is \$24.49 per hour.

Northcentral Technical College believes in providing options for students to ladder from NTC to other colleges and universities offering advanced degrees.
