The following criteria must be met:

Completion of 40 degree credits (transferable WTCS plus UWW credits)

2.75 cumulative grade point average

Attend Professional Education Phase 1 and Phase 2 Meetings (can be completed online prior to enrollement at UWW)

Pass all three portions of the Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST)

Pass with C/s or better or concurrent enrollment in COMM 110.

Pass Technology Competency Assessment.

Experiences with Learners (minimum of 350 hours beginning with freshman year in high school; at least 300 hours of verified experiences from educational facility/facilities such as schools, agencies, institutions, centers, or organizations.)
