 Disclaimer: Students planning to transfer should contact NTC's Transfer Specialist and transfer personnel at UW Green Bay for current transfer information.
 Students will need to show proof of RN licensure before they will be eligible to take upper level nursing courses.
 NTC Nursing - Associate Degree graduates may transfer an additional 24 credits (including 10-809-195) of NTC coursework to fulfill specific UW Green Bay General Education and Nursing support course requirements.

Graduation Requirements: You need at least 120 credits to graduate, 30 of which are the upper level nursing credits typically taken from UWGB. Students must earn 30 residency credits (earned through UWGB).

Transferring Courses: With advisor approval, students may satisfy requirements by transferring courses completed at another institution. **Transferring credits/courses may affect eligibility for All University (Latin) Honors (48 residency credits are required to be eligible for honors).**
