## **Mid-Year Commencement FAQs**

Cap, Gown & Ticket Pick Up: Monday, November 11-Friday, December 6

Your regalia and tickets can be picked up in the Student Leadership Center (D112) Monday-Thursday 7:30 a.m.-7:00 p.m. or Friday 7:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m.

<u>Are you a regional campus student?</u> Beginning November 11, request to have your regalia and tickets sent to your campus by e-mailing studentlife@ntc.edu with your name, student ID number and preferred campus. Please also identify if you are a veteran so you may receive appropriate cords. To allow time for mailing, the deadline to request this service is Friday, December 6.

- **Number of Tickets:** All guests (regardless of age) must have a ticket to attend the ceremony. The number of tickets is determined by the location and the number of graduates. To accommodate all graduates, each participant will be initially allocated 3 guest tickets for the event with an opportunity to obtain extra tickets.
- **Ticket Deadline:** Tickets not picked up by <u>5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 6</u> will be released as extra tickets. If you come in after that time, you may not receive your allocated tickets.
- Extra Tickets: Beginning Monday, December 9, you may pick up 1 extra ticket per day on a first-come, first-serve basis until they are gone.
- **Live Stream:** In an effort to accommodate guests who are unable to attend, the ceremony will be available at waam.viebit.com via live stream and after the ceremony as video on demand.
- **Diploma:** Your diploma will be mailed approximately 6-8 weeks after grading day. Check MyNTC to make sure your name and address are accurate.
- There is no additional cost for your regalia. The cap and gown are yours to keep.
- **Gold Cords** will be given to students who have achieved a cumulative 3.5 or higher GPA as of the prior semester and will be distributed with your cap and gown.
- **Red, White, and Blue Cords** will be given to students who have served our country in the armed forces and can be requested when you pick up your cap and gown.
- White Cords will be given to the Outstanding Graduate in each program and will be distributed by the academic program or designee. Please note not all programs select an Outstanding Graduate.
- Empire Photography has been photographing our commencement ceremony for many years. Each graduate is
  photographed as they receive their diploma and a solo portrait is taken after they exit the stage. Approximately 2 to
  4 weeks after graduation, proofs of the pictures will be sent to graduates via their NTC e-mail. There is no obligation
  to purchase the pictures. More information can be found at http://www.empirephotos.com/.
- You need to be at the Grand Theater, Wausau by **9:00 a.m.** to line up. The graduation ceremony starts at **10:00 a.m.** Line-up instructions will be included with your cap and gown.
- You will have access to a secure area to leave your belongings during the ceremony.
- The ceremony will last approximately two hours and should conclude by 12:00 p.m.
- Student Records will verify final grades and program completion; your diploma will be mailed to you after this process occurs. If you have not received either a letter or your diploma within 8 weeks from grading day, please contact studentrecords@ntc.edu.
