NTC's Radiography Program Credentialing Examination Pass Rates

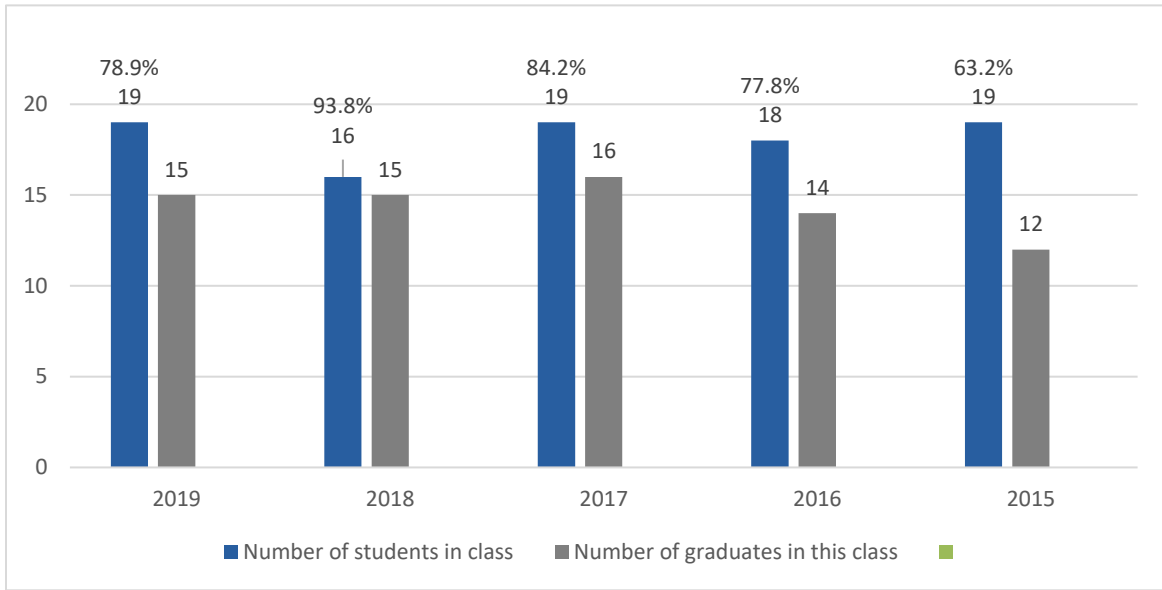
Credentialing examination pass rate is defined as the number of graduates who pass the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) certification examination on the first attempt, compared with the number of graduates who take the examination within six months of graduation.

NTC's Radiography Program Job Placement Rates

| Year | Percent of Graduates Employed in Radiography within twelve months of graduation | Number of graduates employed in Radiography within twelve months of graduation | Number of graduates actively seeking employment in the field | Number of graduates |

Job placement rate is defined as the number of graduates employed in the radiologic sciences compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the field within one year following graduation. Graduates that are continuing their education, on active military duty or unwilling to relocate/accept employment are considered not actively seeking employment in the field. NTC Radiography classes graduate in June of each year.

NTC's Radiography Program Completion Rates



The five year average is 79.1% (72/91) program completion. Program completion rate is defined as the number of students who complete the program within 150% of the stated program length.
