Methodology

The survey population is comprised of students who graduated from NTC within the last three years. Beginning six months after graduation, each NTC graduate was sent a web-based survey to both NTC and personal email addresses. Information in this report summarizes the responses of graduates who were in the labor force, including all employed and unemployed respondents, except those who were unemployed and not seeking employment. A person was considered employed if they worked for pay or profit, full- or part-time, at the time of survey completion.

Full-time employment is defined as 35 or more hours per week; part-time is less than 35 hours per week. The survey asked respondents to classify their jobs as related, or not related, to the training they received. In the information beginning on page 2, those who indicated their job was related to the training they received were counted in the "employed-related" category, a subset of the "employed" category. A minimum of three employed-related respondents must have reported their salary in order for an average to be published. If there were no survey responses for a program or fewer than five graduates in a program, then no labor force or employment data is published.
