

2025 PINE TREE QUILTERS' QUILT COLLEGE
Seasonal Collaged Mini- Quilt - Instructor Teresa Locknane / Red Spool Designs

PLEASE READ ALL OF THE ATTACHED INFORMATION!!

This is a small, easy project that will allow you to learn the underlay method of collage using one of Laura Heine's "Whatevers!" patterns. This pattern will make an 8-9" block that you could turn into a mini wall hanging, potholder, center of a table mat, or collect more of the patterns and make them to sew into a quilt. No machine is needed for this class. Quilting of the collage will be done on your own.

Use of instructor provided art supplies in class
An assortment of the instructor's fabric cuttables for use in class

****KIT DOES NOT INCLUDE FABRICS- You will bring your own prepared fabrics to use for this project.****

We are limited to a few small irons in class due to electrical outlet restrictions, so you must come to class with your fabrics prepared with Steam-a-Seam2. (See pre-class prep instructions).

SUPPLY LIST:

FABRICS	FABRIC SIZE(S)
Backgrounds (6-8)	5" squares of each (have contrast from your truck color)
Truck Front/Bed (2)	4" x 4" each
Fenders	2" x 6"
Rim of bed	2" x 4"
Window/Tire rims	3" x 6"
Tires/bumpers/running board	3" x 4"
Cuttables	4" – 6" squares of small flowers and other cuttable motifs

Non-stick fusing mat	Laura Heine Collage Mat, Goddess Pressing Sheet, Precision Fusing Mat
Small, Serrated edge scissors	Laura Heine Scissors or Karen K. Buckley medium size scissors
Steam-a-Seam2 Regular (not lite)	1 yd. of 18" wide or 1 package of (5) 9" x 12" sheets should be enough
	(No substitutions- Steam-a-Seam2 must be used!!)

You will also need a rotary cutter, cutting mat, and ruler to use in trimming your fabric slabs at home, but you do not need to bring these to class.

PRE-CLASS PREPARATION

READ ALL OF THE PREP INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU START!

Steam-a-Seam2 (SAS2) is repositionable and is permanent once fused. To prep your fabrics for class you will be applying the SAS2 to the back of each of your fabrics.

DRY IRON ONLY, DO NOT USE STEAM FOR ANY OF THIS PROCESS!!

1. Peel back the backing paper of the SAS2 and place your fabrics onto the layer of fusible, right side of the fabric up and wrong side of the fabric against the sticky glue. Fit them in the best you can to avoid wasting SAS2 as much as possible.

Throw away the backing paper you peeled off. It has glue residue on it and you don't want to get that on anything.



2. Lay your non-stick fusing mat on your ironing board.
3. You may need to cut your fabric/SAS2 pieces into segments that fit on your fusing mat before ironing.
4. Place the piece of fabric/fusible onto the fusing mat with the fabric and glue side DOWN so that you are ironing on the paper backing of the SAS2 and so that the sticky glue is against the fusing mat. Using a DRY iron, press until the SAS2 is adhered to the fabrics.
5. If you are using a Laura Heine Collage Mat or Precision Fusing Mat, the excess fusible that is around the fabrics should stay attached with the SAS2 paper. If you are using a Goddess Pressing Sheet the excess glue will be on the pressing sheet. Be sure you wipe this off before pressing another set of fabric/fusible.
6. Using your rotary cutter, ruler, and cutting mat, trim all of the prepared fabric slabs to the edge of the fabrics so there is no fusible or paper around the edges of the fabrics.
7. Place all of your prepared fabric slabs in a Ziploc bag and bring them with you to class!

HERE ARE SOME SAMPLES TO GIVE YOU INSPIRATION IN YOUR THEME AND FABRIC SELECTIONS. You don't need a lot of fabric so dig into that stash for those collaging treasures!! Bring an assortment of things to play with!
