Paying for college

Important Information & Next Steps:

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the application used to determine a student’s eligibility for federal financial aid programs, as well as financial aid offered by the State of Wisconsin. Financial aid eligibility can change from year to year, so it is important to complete the FAFSA annually.

The 2027-2028 FAFSA will be available beginning October 1, 2026. Students graduating from high school in spring 2027 and planning to begin college in fall 2027 should complete the 2027-2028 FAFSA to be considered for federal and state financial aid.

Students who graduate from high school early in December 2026 and plan to start college in spring 2027 will need to complete the 2026-2027 FAFSA, as the spring 2027 term is part of the 2026-2027 academic year.

STEP 1

Go to [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) to create an account and complete the FAFSA form. Both the student and a parent will each need to create their own [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) accounts.

STEP 2

Apply for financial aid with NTC’s school code 005387.

What you will need:

- Social security number
- Driver’s license number
- Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Records of untaxed income, such as child support received and interest income
- The FAFSA uses “prior-prior year” tax information, meaning you must report the income and tax data from two years prior to the academic year you are applying. For example, if you are looking to attend college in spring 2027, you would file the 2026-2027 FAFSA using tax information from 2024. If you are looking to attend college in fall 2027, you would file the 2027-2028 FAFSA using tax information from 2025.
- Information on cash, savings and checking account balances and investments

STEP 3

NTC’s Financial Aid Office will email you after receiving your processed FAFSA.

Check your NTC student email account for additional information about financial aid which may include:

- Request for additional documents needed to fully process your FAFSA (referred to as verification)
- Notification of a financial aid offer
- Campus Store voucher, which allows students to purchase textbooks and required supplies upfront using anticipated excess financial aid. You are generally eligible if your approved financial aid exceeds your tuition and fees.
- Work-study

Please note: Along with filing the FAFSA, students need to be accepted into an eligible program and enrolled in classes that count toward their program of study to be offered financial aid. Most communications from the Financial Aid Office will come by email and through notifications and tasks in your Workday student account. We recommend checking your NTC email regularly and logging into Workday to stay on top of any updates.

Dependent Student vs. Independent Student

A dependent student is assumed to be financially supported by their parents, is usually under the age of 24, unmarried, without dependents and not a veteran or currently serving in the U.S. military. Not living with parents or not being claimed by them on tax forms does not make you a student independent for purposes of applying for federal student aid. If you don’t have contact with your parents, don’t know where they live, have left home because of an unsafe or abusive situation or your parents won’t provide their information, please reach out to us in the Financial Aid Office to help and walk you through your options.

NTC Promise

NTC Promise provides free college tuition for qualified local high school graduates in the NTC district. This opportunity helps high school seniors realize their dreams of attending college while reducing financial barriers and ensuring a skilled workforce for our communities.

Through the generosity of the NTC Foundation, businesses and individual donors, the cost of tuition and fees will be covered by donated funds after federal and state financial aid (excluding loans and work-study) and scholarships have been applied.

We will provide up to five consecutive semesters of tuition free attendance for qualified students (up to 15 credits per semester; does not include summer semester) who meet ongoing requirements.

Promise participants will receive individual guidance and support from a dedicated advisor as they navigate the eligibility requirements of their program.

Scholarships: Apply for a Scholarship

NTC Foundation scholarships can be applied for twice each year, in the fall and spring semesters. Scholarships awarded will be applied to the following semester.

Before applying, you should know:

- NTC Foundation scholarships are established with donor-determined criteria; however, ONE online application qualifies students for ALL available scholarships. Visit www.ntc.edu/scholarships for details
- NTC Foundation scholarships are NOT cash awards; scholarships are deposited directly into student accounts at the beginning of the following semester
- Scholarship awards may be taken into account on your next year's Federal Financial Aid application
- If your books and tuition are fully covered by another entity such as dislocated worker or veteran's benefits, these scholarships may not be helpful to you

Work Study: Financial Aid

Financial aid helps you and your family pay for your education. Some aid needs to be paid back, while some is considered gift-aid (including grants and scholarships) and does not need to be repaid if satisfactory academic progress is being made.

The amount of financial aid you are eligible for depends on a number of factors, such as your financial need, veteran status and other variables.

The work-study program provides part-time jobs for eligible students with financial need, allowing them to earn money to help pay educational expenses. Eligibility is determined by completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

Veterans Affairs (VA) and Military Benefits

Veterans, service members and their eligible dependents may qualify for VA and military benefits. Benefits could potentially cover the cost of tuition and/or offset other costs associated with your education.

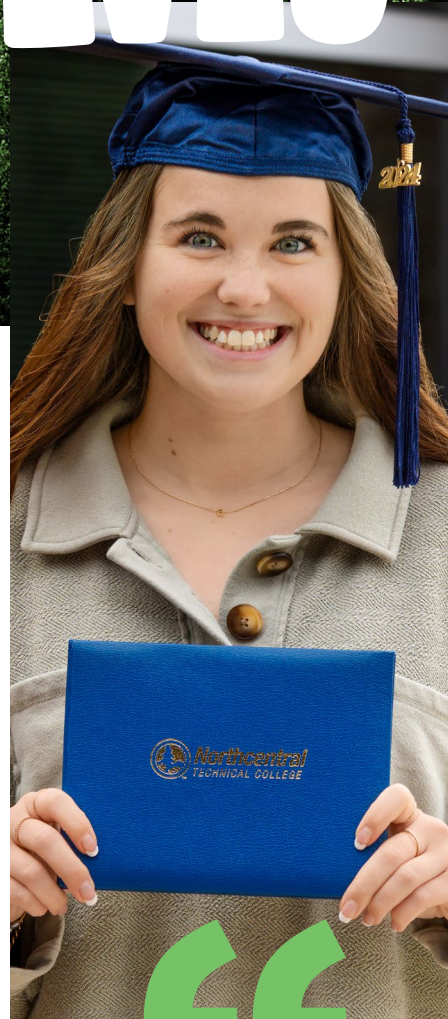

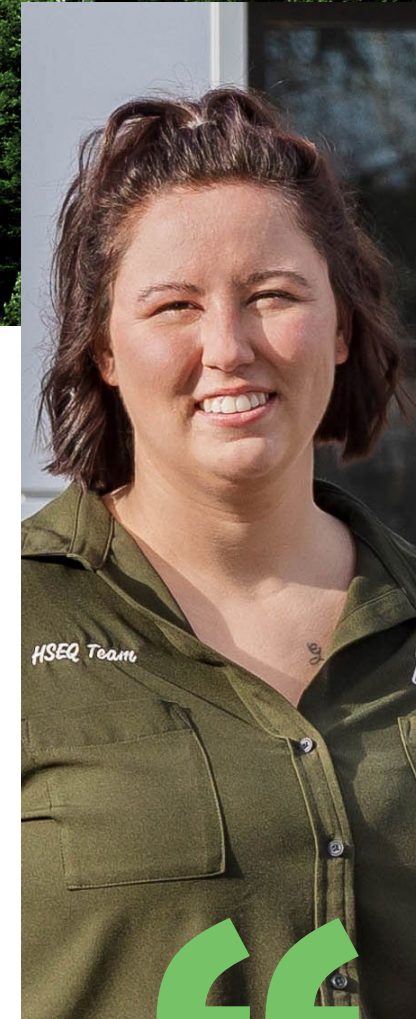

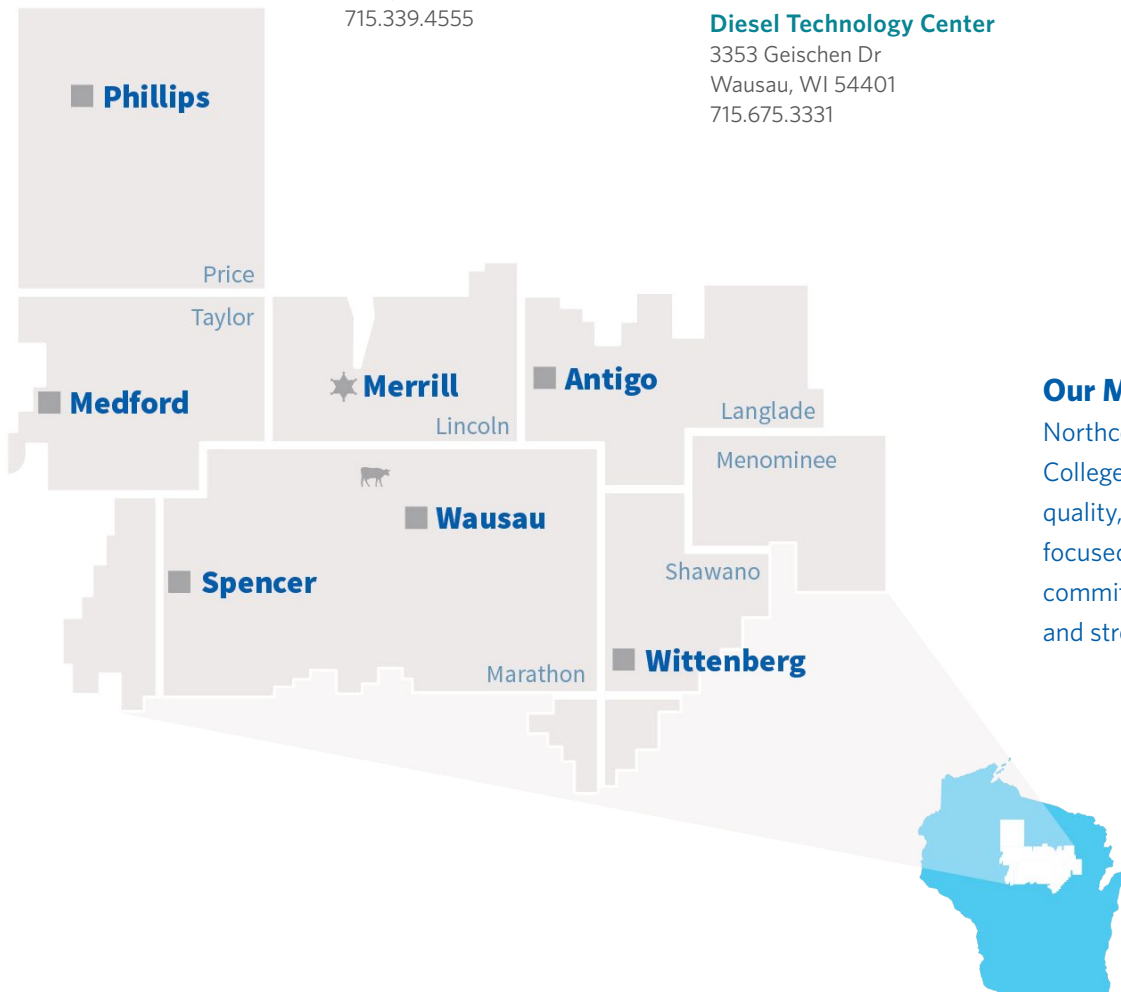
