C. CHS Dental Clinic Renovation – Chet Strebe

D. CHS Dental Therapy Addition – Chet Strebe

Mike Endreas moved and Tom Felch seconded the Northcentral Technical College District Board approval of the CHS Dental Therapy Addition at a cost not to exceed \$1,300,000 (\$1,300,000 from state appropriations) and requests the WTCS State Board to do the same. Motion carried unanimously.

Charlie Paulson moved and Tucona Crowder seconded the Northcentral Technical College District Board approval of the 2024-2025 employee salary/wage adjustments as indicated in the topic summary sheet. Motion carried unanimously.
