SPEAKER INFORMATION

Mark Dwyer

Mark owns and operates Landscape Prescriptions by MD, a landscape design and consultation business in Janesville, Wisconsin. Prior to this, Mark was Director of Horticulture at Rotary Botanical Gardens (Janesville, Wisconsin) for 21 years. He has degrees in landscape architecture (University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign) and urban forestry (UW-Stevens Point). Mark's true passion is anything related to horticulture!

Presentation: Transitional Seasonal Containers - We will discuss how to maximize the impact and duration of container arrangements for all four seasons. The basics of container selection and preparation will be covered briefly with the primary feature consisting of a wide range of ideas for seasonal compositions in all four seasons in the same containers.
