\*\*You must possess one of the documents listed above to be eligible for financial aid. You are not eligible for financial aid if you are in the United States under one of the following designations:

- An F1 or F2 student visa
- A J1 or J2 exchange visitor visa
- A G series visa (pertaining to international organizations)
- If you have only an Employment Authorization Card (I-688A)
