This Acceptance of Risks and Responsibility Agreement and Release of Liability (“Agreement and Release”) is executed by: _____ (please print first and last name (“Participant”)) and is issued to NORTHCENTRAL TECHNICAL COLLEGE (“COLLEGE”).

Participant is participating in the “Make It Real” Summer Camp event at NTC, which takes place at NTC’s Wausau Campus. This activity is more fully described in the event flyer, which has been provided to Participant.

Participant understands that there are certain dangers, hazards, and risks inherent in the Activity.
