WIOA 167 Program:

Helps farmworker families get education and training to obtain good-paying jobs with benefits. Veterans & eligible spouses, including widows/widowers & spouses of MIA, receive priority service.

WHAT KIND OF SCHOOLING?

Short-term (2 years or less)

- ✓Agriculture: ex. Ag Equipment Tech/Animal Science
- ✓Construction: ex. Lineman/Electricity
- ✓Healthcare: ex. CNA/Nursing/Phlebotomy
- ✓Logistics: ex. CDL/Operations Manager
- ✓Manufacturing: ex. Welding/CNC Tech
