### 10-522-103 | 3 CREDITS

#### EDU: INTRO TO ED PRACTICES

Analyzes pre-K-12 education in the United States, determines roles and responsibilities of school personnel, and explores current trends and best practices. Learners identify how students learn and the foundations of lesson planning. Analyze assessment strategies, classroom management, and techniques for supporting learners.

### 10-522-104 | 3 CREDITS

#### EDU: TECHNOLOGY IN EDUCATION

Develops the knowledge and skills to use trending classroom technologies and gain experience creating and using web tools including portfolios. Learners create presentations for educational environments and identify ISTE Standards.

### 10-522-106 | 3 CREDITS

#### EDU: CHILD & ADOLESCENT DEV

Provides an overview of physical, motor, perceptual, cognitive, social/emotional and growth and development birth through adolescence. Analyzes social, parental, cultural, brain, and economic influences on development.
